



Creating and Placing Your Custom Banner Images Into Your Blueball Showcase Sandvox Designs

Directions for Placing Your Own Custom Banner Images Into Your Showcase Design Layout.

The Blueball Showcase design allows you to easily change out the default banner image that comes with each Showcase design with your own custom banner image.

We provide you with a layered Photoshop file with all the banner colors, the gloss white overlay layer, and the 2 page slit shadows, all on individual layers. We also include a layer mask for you to use that automatically crops your image to fit the specified area in the overall banner image layout. You have to drag your image into the file and drop it onto the layer where it says “Drag Your Image Here”. Then select the layer and drag your image to further position it within the layer mask for final positioning. **The actual active area for your image to go into the layer mask area within the provided photoshop file is 947px wide by 146px tall.** The overall finished banner image size is 996px wide by 165px tall.

You can open this file up in the image editor of your choice that supports layered Photoshop files. **Your custom banner image must be saved as a .jpg image file and be named banner.jpg.** We recommend saving your 72dpi RGB jpg image file with a 85% to 100% quality setting using the save to web feature if available in your image editor.

After creating your new banner image, open up the Site Inspector window, click the Media tab and then drag your image into the box labeled “Banner” or use the “Select” button to choose your custom banner image, and your new banner image will replace the default image used in the design automatically.
