



## Placing Your Custom Banner and Optional Second Images Into The Blueball Trifecta Sandvox Designs

### Directions for Placing Your Own Custom Banner Images Into Your Trifecta Design Layout.

The Blueball Trifecta design layout allows you to easily change out the default banner image with your own custom banner image.

For your convenience, we have included a layered Photoshop CS3 image file called trifecta\_banner\_master.psd to use to create your own custom banner image with.

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**NOTE! - Your custom banner image must be exactly 568px wide by 178px tall or your banner image will not display correctly with your Trifecta designs. It must be named banner.jpg and saved for the web as a 72dpi RGB jpg image file. We recommend saving your image file using a 60% to 80% quality setting to keep your file size small so it will load and display quickly on your site pages.**

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After creating your new banner image, open up the Site Inspector window, click the Media tab and then drag your image into the box labeled "Banner" or use the "Select" button to choose your custom banner image, and your new banner image will replace the default image used in the design automatically.

*\*IMPORTANT! - The new banner swap function requires Sandvox 1.5 and will not work correctly on earlier versions of Sandvox.*

### Directions for Placing Your Own Optional Custom Second Image Into Your Trifecta Design Layout.

For the first time the Blueball Trifecta design layout allows you to add in an optional second image into the top of the right hand column area. By default this image is solid white in color.

For your convenience, we have included a Photoshop CS3 image file called Trifecta\_righttopwhite.psd to use to create your own custom second image with.

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**NOTE! - Your custom second image must be exactly 230px wide by 178px tall or your second image will not display correctly in your Trifecta design layout. It must be named Trifecta\_righttopwhite2.jpg and saved for the web as a 72dpi RGB jpg image file. We recommend saving your image file using a 60% to 80% quality setting to keep your file size small so it will load and display quickly on your site pages.**

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A couple of things to remember when creating your custom second image:

- The background of the image must be white.
- We recommend leaving a white margin around whatever image item you drop into the photoshop file. See our demo sites for Trifecta and how we have placed items into the second image area. This option works best for silhouetted items placed on a white background we have found.

## **How To Place Your New Custom Second Image Into Your Page Layout!**

After creating your new second image, you need to add it into your Trifecta design's Contents folder. This is not difficult to do, and can be done by doing the following: Go to Sandvox's Application Support folder where all third party designs are loaded by default. You can find this folder here: User > Library > Application Support > Sandvox.

Select and highlight the Trifecta design you are using for your site and while holding down the "Control" key click on it. Select "Show Package Contents" in the window that appears. A new window will appear that has all the design's files in it. Now drag and drop in your new second image file replacing the one that's currently there. That's it - you're done! Now your new custom second image will appear on all your site's pages.
